

**Constitution**  
of the  
**Hastings Community Association**

1. The name of the Society is the Hastings Community Association.
2. The purposes of the society are:
  - a. To promote and assist in any and all ways all kinds of endeavor of a charitable, social, cultural, sporting, recreational and of a community character, and for the purpose of so doing to buy or otherwise acquire such equipment and things as may be needed therefore.
  - b. To take, hold and acquire by purchase, donation, devise or otherwise all kinds of personal property, and real estate, and to erect or cause to be erected and maintained thereon playgrounds of any and all kinds and descriptions and to erect and maintain necessary buildings such as may be required to promote the objects of the society, and to sell, exchange, mortgage, lease, let, improve and develop the same.
  - c. To operate a community centre to be used for programs, workshops, athletics, art, music, handicrafts, hobbies, and recreation for the benefit of the general public.
